

Guide to IRA Charitable Rollovers

With an IRA Charitable Rollover gift you can support the work of the Catholic Community Foundation and enjoy valuable tax benefits by making a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). Your gift may even count toward your Required Minimum Distribution for the year. *This information is not intended as tax, legal, or financial advice. Tax Benefits

If you make a QCD, you will not have to pay federal income tax on the amount of your rollover gift. This is especially an advantage for IRA owners who do not need the required distribution to live on, and who do not want to pay income taxes on required IRA distributions. If you wish to make a gift to the Catholic Community Foundation, you can give from your IRA instead of your cash accounts.

Requirements and Limitations

1. Donors must be age 70 ½ years or older on the date of the gift.
2. In 2026, the maximum QCD is \$111,000 per individual.
3. Contributions can only be made from traditional IRAs.

How to Make a Gift from your IRA

1. Contact your IRA administrator to request a distribution check payable to:

2. Notify the Catholic Community Foundation of your name, address, phone number, email and designated endowment to ensure the proper use of your gift. You may also share that information with your IRA administrator.
