



Inspired by St. Joseph



St. Joseph was a quiet man, strong and righteous. We never hear him speak in the Bible, yet we know he certainly listened. He lived behind the scenes, fulfilling God's command to him that he love and protect Jesus and Mary. Thus the Catholic Community Foundation of Mid-Michigan (CCFMM) has established a new fund in the holy name of St. Joseph, faithful spouse and father.

Kristin Smith, CCFMM Executive Director, was inspired to create the Saint Joseph Giving Society (SJGS) based on the present urgent behind-the-scenes needs she sees at the Foundation. To continue to operate effectively beyond its first 15 years, Kristin believes the Foundation needs a funding support for staffing and operational expenses. In addition, this fund will also be a source of revenue for evangelization such as providing all 6th grade students in the Saginaw Catholic Diocese with their own Bibles.

Just as St. Joseph heard and acted on God's call, Kristin prays the community will be receptive to CCFMM's request for donations to the SJGS. According to Kristin, "The St. Joseph Giving Society will help CCFMM annually disperse nearly \$1.5 million in funds, scholarships, and donor advised funds."

Giving from the Heart



Bishop Robert Gruss gives his blessing and full support to the St. Joseph Giving Society by offering the following benefits for each level of giving:

-  \$1,000 Giving Level - An invitation to the Summer Picnic & Annual Mass
-  \$5,000 Giving Level - An invitation to an Advent or Lenten Retreat Day, Summer Picnic and Annual Mass
-  \$10,000 Giving Level—Dinner with Bishop Gruss, invitation to Advent or Lenten Retreat Day, and Summer Picnic & Annual Mass

In this year of St. Joseph, as established by Pope Francis, Joe Day, CCFMM Board member since 2019, believes the establishment of the SJGS is vital. Joe currently serves on the CCFMM Executive and Development Committees, and he says the creation of the SJGS has been the Development Committee's primary task for the past several months.

According to Joe, "The objective of the SJGS is to support the operational costs of the Foundation, which will allow us to reduce the amount deducted from the annual earnings of the CCFMM. If a certain number of people donate to the SJGS on an annual basis, this allows us to distribute more money to the philanthropic funds, those which support scholarships, schools, seminarians, and the poor."
